► **School Hours/Aftercare:** Regular school hours are Monday- Thursday 8:15am-3:15pm, Fridays 8:15am- 2pm. Kindergarten always dismisses at 11:30am, but may use Kindergarten aftercare until school dismisses. On half days (noon dismissal), Kindergarteners with older siblings may stay until the noon dismissal (no aftercare on half days). On regulars days After School Care begins at 3:25, and runs until 4:30pm. All Aftercare is charged at \$2 per half hour. Please let your teacher know if your student will be in aftercare on a specific schedule, or let them know ASAP that your child will need it for the day. You may also contact the office at 269-683-5444.

► **7th/8th Vespers @ Crawford Cottage:** Friday, August 28th at 6:30pm-8pm. Please bring a dish to share for a potluck. ► **Student Drop-Off & Pick-Up:** Please enter the school/Church parking lot from the first entrance off of the dirt road. We will line up along the far right side parking spots, leaving space for vehicles to park in the center parking spots. The line will proceed to the front of the school, and exit out of the parking lot on the west side of the church (onto Grant St.)

► **One Call Now" Phone System:** We use a phone alert system to instantly provide important notifications to our families during the school year. You will be able to hear all of the really important news that it has for you. **To opt into text messaging, text ALERT to 22300.**

► **Lunch Card/Tuition payments:** Lunches are **\$4.50 each** or you can purchase a **Lunch card at \$36 per card (8 lunches)**. *All lunches are vegetarian, but not necessarily gluten, dairy or nut free.* You can purchase in the office with cash/check, or through our website, under the "tuition rates & payments" tab. This online system can also be used for tuition payments throughout the year. The options online are credit card or electronic check. ***The electronic check fee (paid by the school) is much, much lower than the credit card fee, so an electronic check is much preferred as it saves NAS large fees.***

► **Galaxy Roller Skating:** Friday October 2nd, 11:45pm-1:45pm. **Many APPROVED drivers will be needed for this event.** More information will be coming soon.
