It's a time for rejoicing! "The Lord has done great things for us, and we are glad" (Psalm 126:3). On September 10, 2023, the North Knoxville Church Board voted to submit an application to the Federal Communications Commission to seek a license to operate a low-power FM radio station on our campus. The FCC had announced that a frequency might be available in the Knoxville area. Many prayers accompanied our application. Evidence of God's approval and leading were evident. We are pleased to report that after 28 months of working to obtain permits and approvals at the Federal, State, and County levels, on January 9, 2026, our official license was granted. The call letters and frequency we have been assigned are WNKM-LP, 107.1 FM. All the broadcasting equipment has been installed and the station is live on the air 24/7. We thank the North Knoxville Church family and friends for their prayers and continued financial support for our community radio outreach. Our Church Board has voted that monies given to "Media Evangelism" (one of the accounts in our church budget), will be used to fund the radio station. If a person wanted to donate directly to the radio station this would be a "Non Tax-deductible" option.
