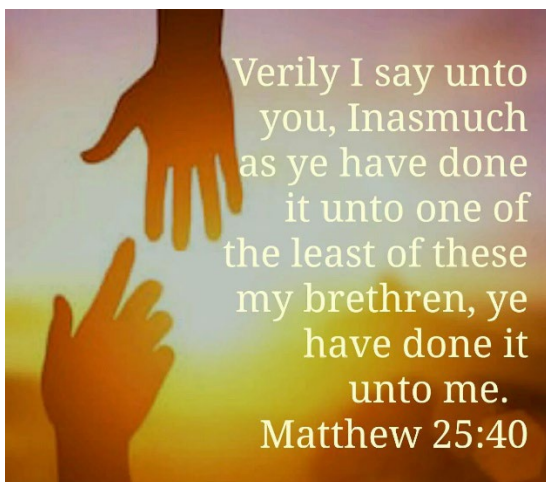
Their vision is to empower families to thrive by meeting their basic needs, enabling them to pursue work, education, and personal growth.
