Ed Tidwell asks for continued prayers for the salvation of his daughter and grandson.

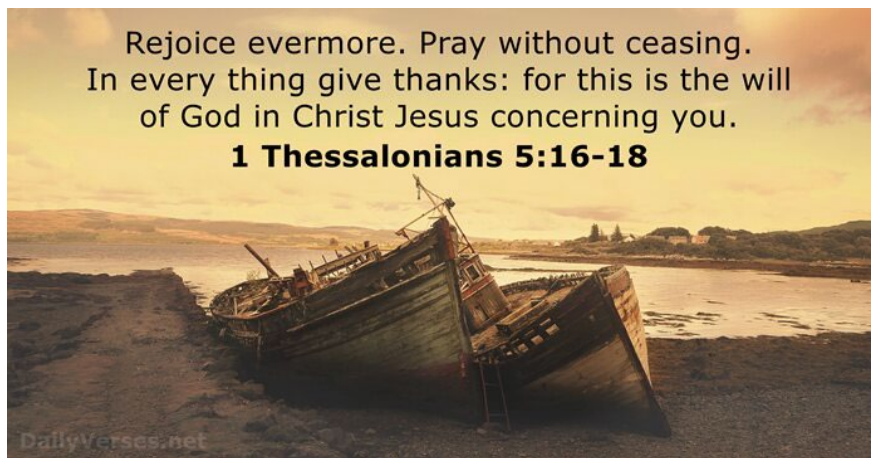
Please continue to pray for the members in our church no longer attending. May God strengthen and heal them both physically and spiritually, according to His will.
