Continue to pray for Susie for spiritual guidance in dealing with her family.

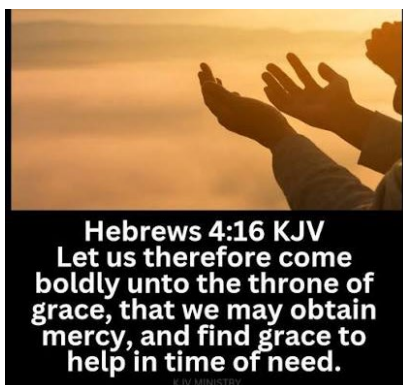
Ed Tidwell asks for continued prayers for the salvation of his daughter and grandson.
