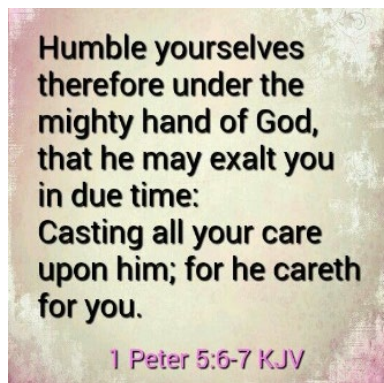
PRAISE

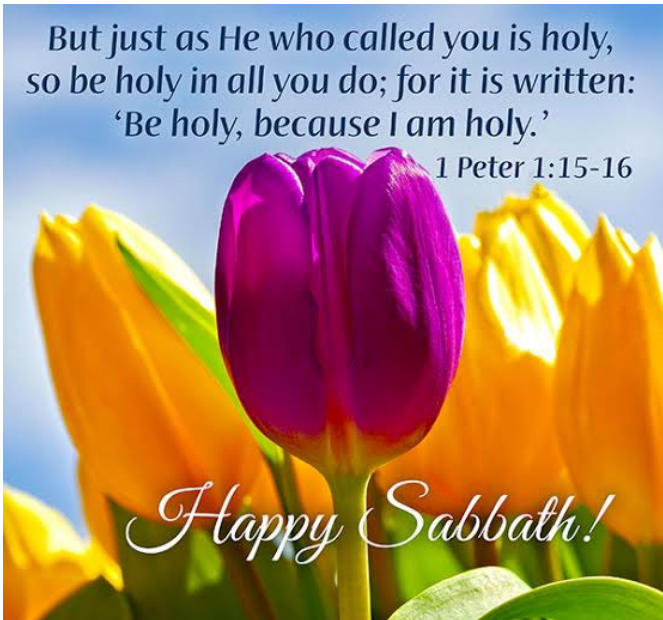
