Pray for those involved in a deadly accident in the Philippines while on a mission trip.

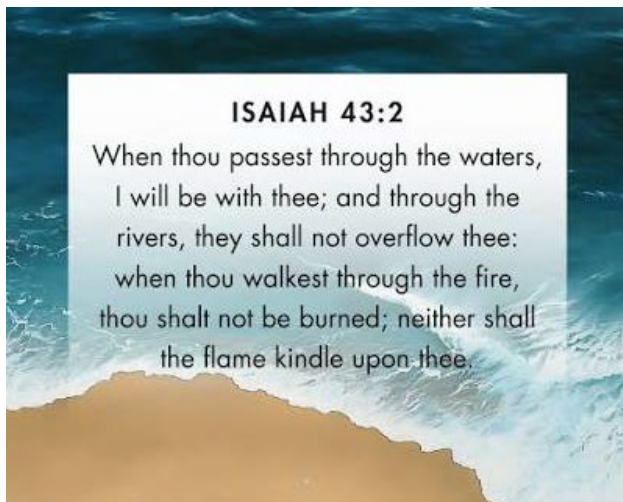
Ed Tidwell requests prayer for an upcoming surgery on September 9.
