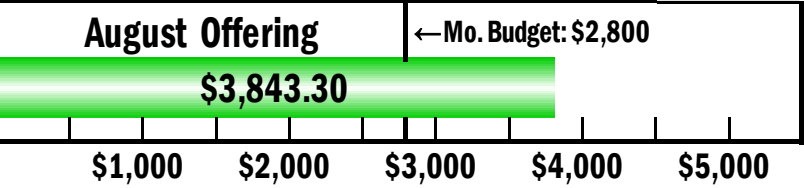


Church Financial Summary
