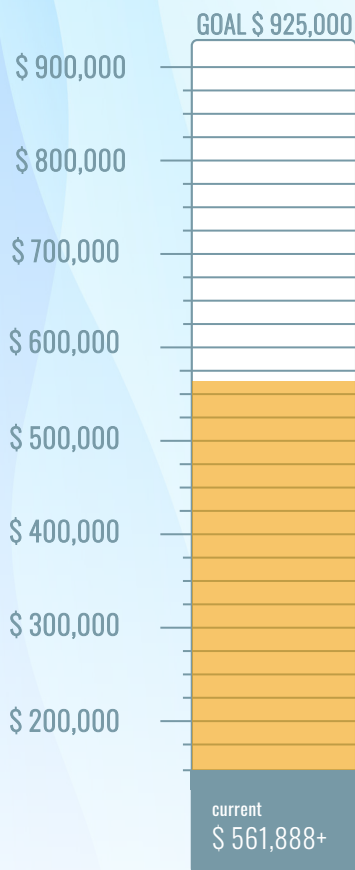
Friday Night Youth Vespers
