On-Line Giving Option Available: For those of you who would like to give on-line instead of writing checks for your giving to the church, you may go to the church website and make that happen.

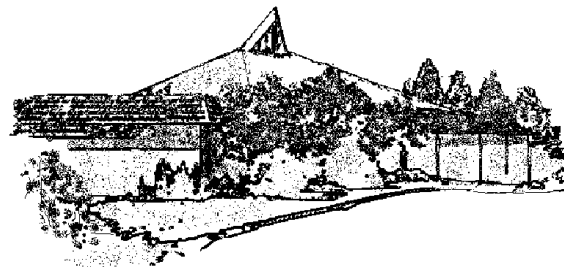
