

SCHOOL DRESS CODE

All Savannah Adventist Christian School students are required to wear school-approved uniforms. No exceptions to the uniform policy will be permitted. Any student out of uniform will be sent to the office to call for the appropriate attire, which a parent is expected to bring before the child returns to class.

Beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, uniform tops must have the SACS logo imprint. It is our goal to make the school uniform policy financially affordable to parents.

Uniform tops (polos and outerwear) are approved from two vendors: [Schoolbelles](#) offers an embroidered logo. Our school code is S3211. [Metro School Uniforms](#) offers heat-transferred or screen-printed logo. Search for our school name on their website.

Uniform-style bottoms are also available from both vendors. If you choose to purchase uniform-style bottoms from other vendors, please be sure they match the style and colors available from our approved vendors.

1. Polo shirts: Shirts must be polo style with a collar and buttons, and the appropriate size for the child. Shirts must be tucked into bottoms. Undergarments should not be visible beneath uniforms. **Color:** hunter green, navy, maroon. NOTE: Red and white are no longer SACS uniform colors.

2. Uniform-style bottoms: Pants, shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be the appropriate size for the child and must look like the approved uniforms on [on our partner vendor sites](#). No baggy pants or “slim-fitting” pants are to be worn. No knit, jogging or cargo pants, no fleece, denim, or jeans. No zippers or pockets on pant legs. Pants shall be worn so that the waistband is worn at the waist. A fitting belt must be

worn with any garment with belt loops. **Color:** navy or khaki; an optional plaid skirt or jumper is available for girls from schoolbelles.com.

2a. Shorts, skorts, jumpers, skirts and dresses: The hem of these items shall be no higher than 3 inches above the knee.

2b. Tights, leggings, or shorts of solid khaki, white, black, or navy color should be worn under skirts, jumpers, and dresses for modesty purposes. Tights and leggings may not be worn as an outer garment.

3. Shoes and socks: All students shall wear socks and shoes. Shoes shall be closed toe and closed heel so as to protect the entire foot, and should be appropriate for active play. Crocs are not allowed. Sock color: solid navy, khaki, black, or white color.

4. P.E. Uniforms (grades 5-8): A maroon t-shirt with logo, black pants or shorts with logo, and laced athletic shoes are required attire for P.E. classes. One (1) PE T-shirt is provided for all students grades 5-8 each year. Black leggings may be worn under the black shorts if desired. PE T-shirts are available for order if an additional shirt is needed. P.E. attire is available for purchase from Metro School Uniforms.

5. Field Trip Uniforms: A field trip T-shirt will be provided for all enrolled students, which must be worn on all field trips, paired with plain blue jeans.

6. Outerwear: Coats and jackets shall be appropriately sized for the student and may be worn when the weather conditions dictate, and must be removed before entering the classroom. Only logo-bearing outerwear or solid navy cardigans will be permitted in the classrooms. Outerwear is available for purchase from both of our partner vendors; any hood must remain down while inside the building. Hats and other head coverings are not allowed in the classrooms. Please write name on all outerwear.

7. Jewelry: Jewelry is not permitted, including earrings, bracelets, rings. Students who need to keep a fresh piercing open may wear clear blanks until the hole is healed.

8. Hair and Cosmetics: Hair should not obstruct vision and should not be of an unnatural color. The excessive use of cosmetics (makeup) is not permitted. Nails must be short and of a natural color.

9. General Guidelines for dress-down, school spirit, and school performance days:

- a. If you are not sure, do not wear it. Slits, tears, and holes are not allowed.
- b. Shorts/skirts are to be no higher than 3 inches above the knee.
- c. Tops must have sleeves, and should cover the tummy at all times. No words on tops.
- d. Graphics must be limited to those appropriate for a Christian educational environment. Emblems and logos, including those depicting skulls and occult themes, may not be worn on any clothing item and may not be on student book bags (backpacks) or any item brought by the student to school.
- e. Additionally, wearing wireless air pods and/or smartwatches is not allowed. These items should be turned in every morning in the same fashion as cell phones.
