Our Vision

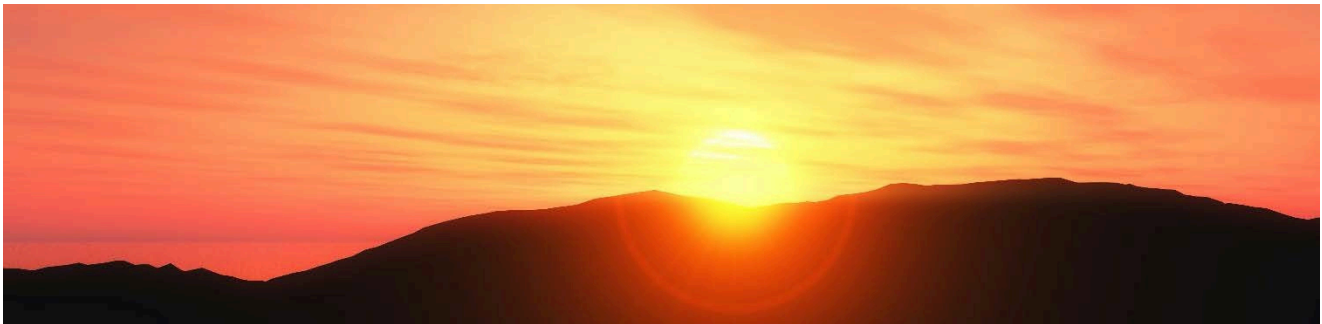
