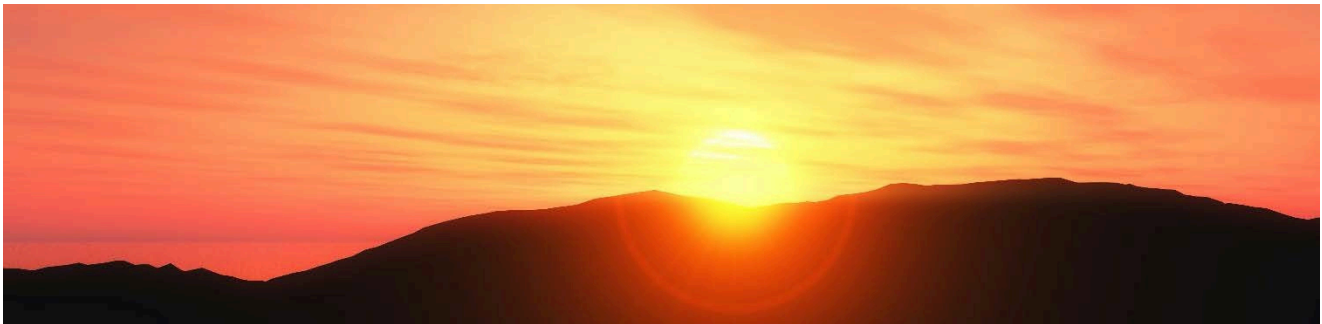

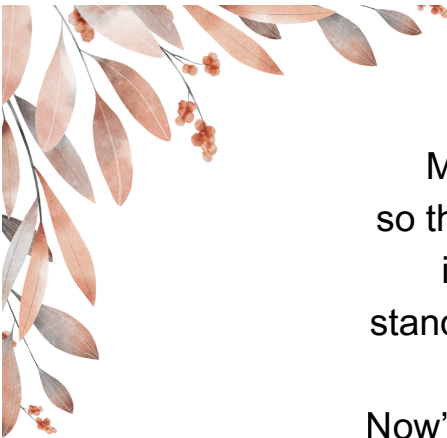
**HOURS**—The Pantry will be open Sunday, July 5 from 10am to 2pm.

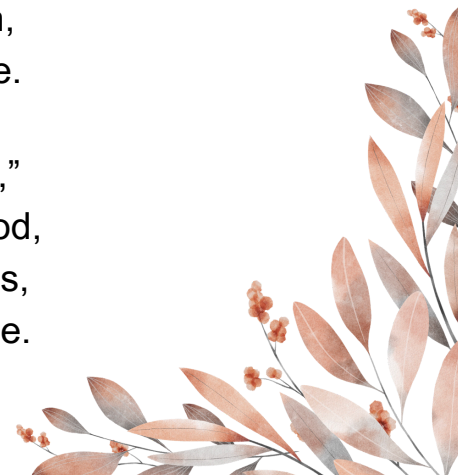
## My Will Or His
