Our Vision

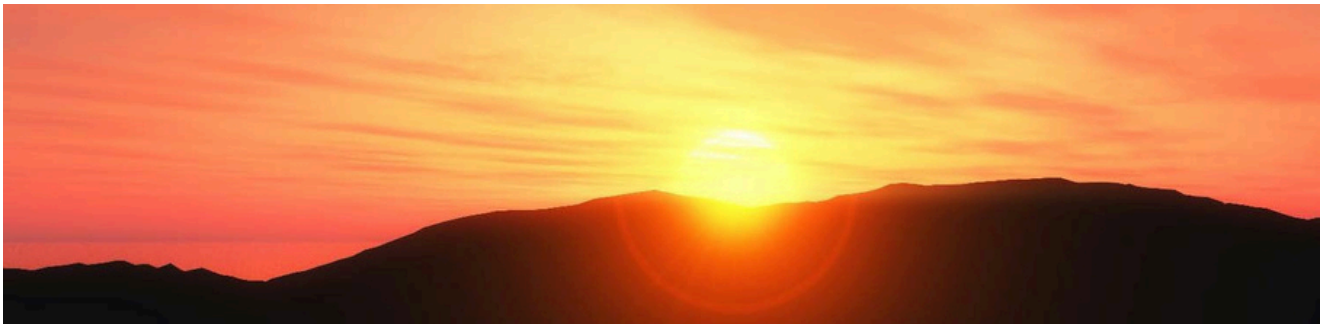

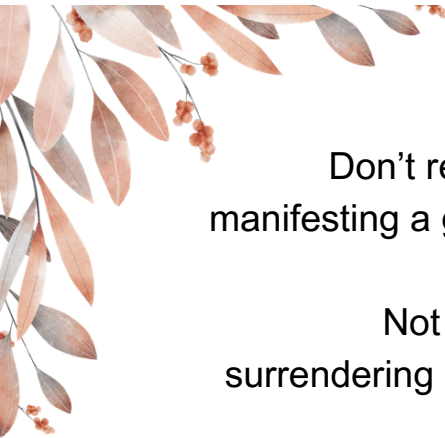
HOURS—The Pantry will be open Sunday, July 12 from 10am to 2pm.

Choices

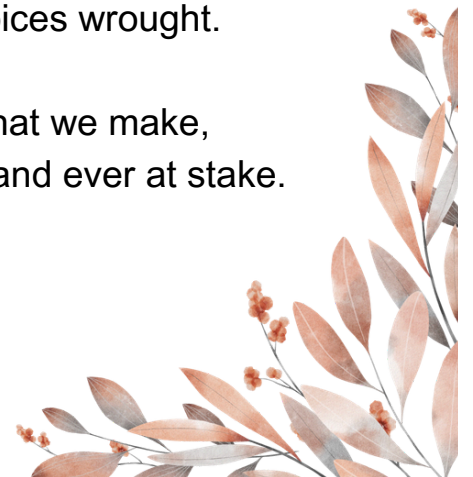
Don't return evil for evil, but repay evil with good,
