Technology & Internet Use Policy • School Year 2026–2027

Hilltop Christian School provides access to technology and the Internet to support learning and enhance educational opportunities. This policy outlines the expectations for appropriate and responsible use. Parents acknowledge this policy, and students sign it, on the Signature & Consent Packet during registration.

Student Responsibilities

- Use technology for educational purposes only
- Respect the privacy and property of others
- Use appropriate language in all digital communications
- Do not access inappropriate websites or content
- Report any inappropriate content or cyberbullying immediately
- Do not share passwords or personal information online
- Follow all teacher instructions regarding technology use

Personal Devices

Cell phones and other electronic devices are not to be turned on during school hours. If a student brings a cell phone or any other electronic device to school, it is to be turned in to the office or the teacher before school begins. Devices not turned in will be confiscated and held until the student's parent comes to retrieve them.

Monitoring & Violations

The school monitors technology use. Violations of this policy may result in loss of technology privileges and/or disciplinary action, consistent with the discipline policies in the Parent & Student Handbook.

Parent/Guardian Agreement

Parents are asked to review this policy with their child before signing the acknowledgment on the Signature & Consent Packet. By signing, the parent agrees to support the school's technology use policies, and the student agrees to follow the responsibilities above.
