Thank you, parents for your help with this project.

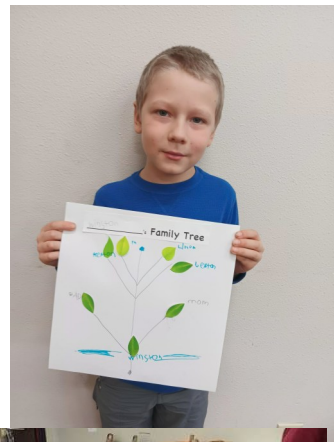
