1. 1 Corinthians 12:12-13 (NKJV)

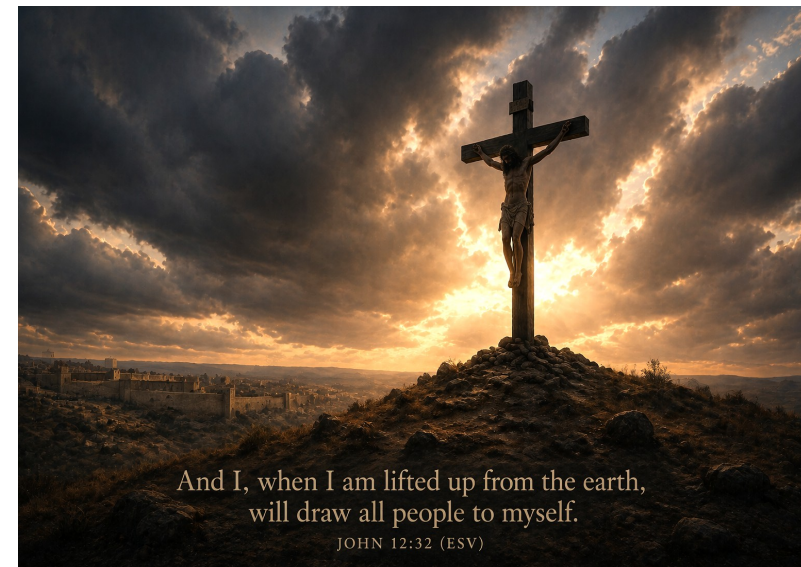
