There are many ways of labeling the type of relationships we have. Here's one way of looking at it:

- 1. Utility friendship** – two people are friends because of work or business; it is transactional in nature.
- 2. Pleasure friendship** – mutual interests (like hobbies) bringing people together. Mutual admiration.
- 3. "Perfect" friendship** – goes beyond previous two levels, and it is focused on improving the circumstance of the other person.

Another way of looking at friendship:

A. The Friend to Laugh With: This friend provides joy, shared memories, lightheartedness, and fun

C. The Friend to Grow With: a true friendship in which two or more people agree to grow together. This friend inspires you, holds you to high standards, and celebrates your evolution rather than feeling threatened by it.
