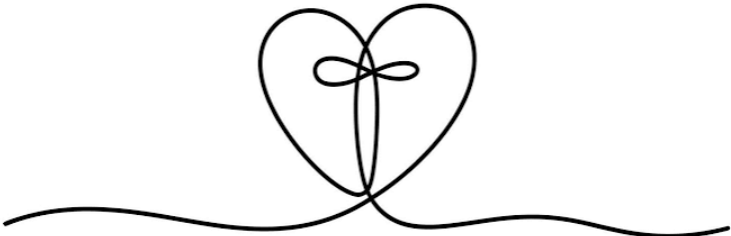

Health Nugget What causes low iron?
Many people assume low iron simply means they aren't eating enough iron-rich foods. While diet can play a role, there are several reasons your body's iron stores (ferritin) may become depleted. Some common causes include:

- Heavy menstrual periods
- Pregnancy and breastfeeding, when iron needs are higher
- Frequent blood donation
- A diet low in iron-rich foods
- Digestive conditions such as celiac disease, inflammatory bowel disease, or previous stomach or intestinal surgery that reduce iron absorption
- Certain medications, including long-term use of acid-reducing medications, which can decrease iron absorption
- Chronic blood loss, such as bleeding ulcers or colon polyps
- Endurance exercise, which can increase the body's iron needs

Sometimes more than one of these factors is contributing, which is why it's important to identify the underlying cause instead of simply replacing the iron.
