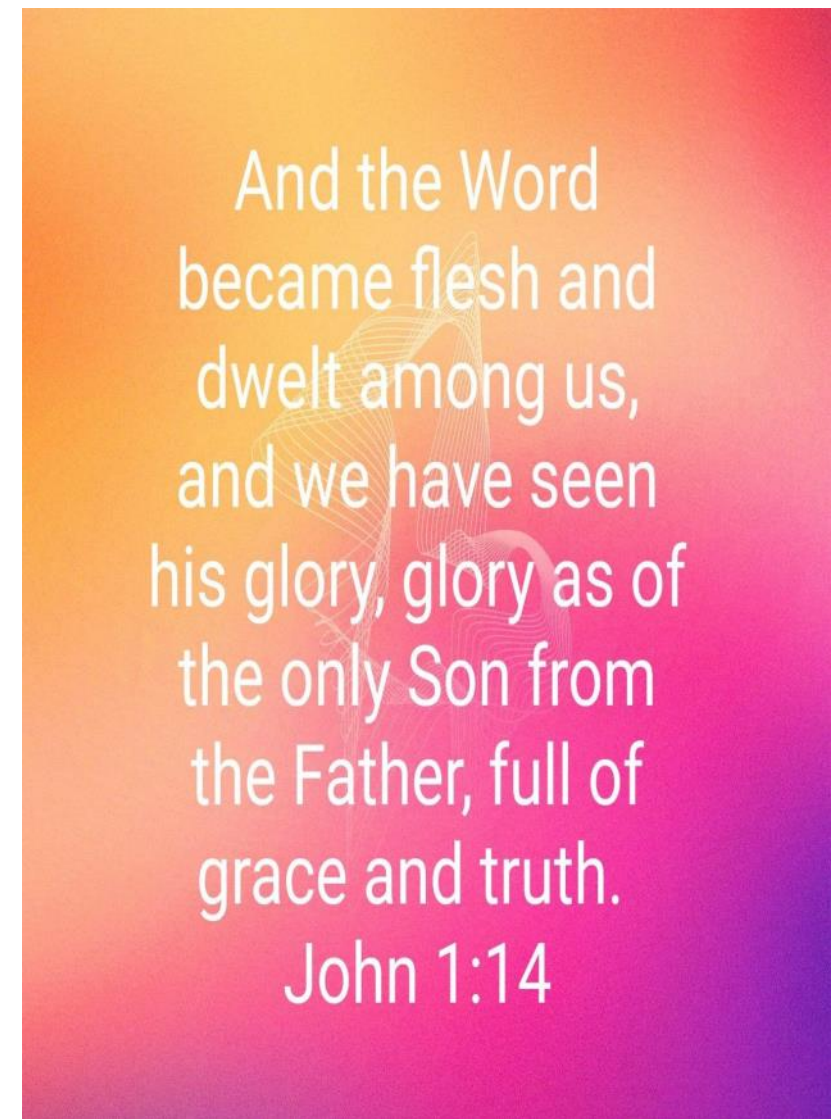

From Pastor Tim's Desk

The Scripture for today is: Psalm 105:4

Seek the LORD, and His strength; seek His face evermore.

The issues that we confront daily, in a world immersed in darkness and evil, requires a strength much greater than our own. We need supernatural strength to stand in the midst of trials, temptations and opposition. Fortunately, that strength is available to us; God gives it freely to those who seek Him. We are on a journey and the path we walk sometimes gets difficult. The road is not always smooth and it is often against stiff resistance from the enemy as we stand in truth and continue to go forward. When confronted by the approach of Pharaoh's army behind them and the Red Sea in front of them, the children of Israel were filled with fear. And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. The LORD will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace." And the LORD said to Moses, "Why do you cry to Me? Tell the children of Israel to go forward." **Exodus 14:13-15**

God had already heard the prayers of His people. He brought them out of Egypt through a mighty display of His power. But in the midst of a great trial they became fearful and began to respond out of that fear instead of standing in faith. But God, who is always watching over His people, provided His strength when they had none. He delivered them once again by His mighty power.
