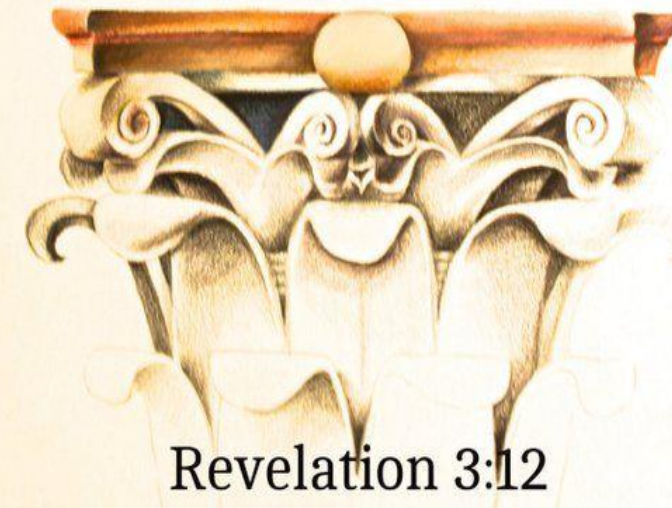

From Pastor Tim's Desk

The Scripture for today is: Proverbs 3:6

In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths.

It is critical for us, in every decision we make, to be completely dependent upon the direction of the Lord. The enemy of our soul works diligently to distract us from reliance upon Christ, enticing us to rely upon our own experiences and limited understanding. It is not our knowledge or inclinations that should lead us. It is only through Christ within us that the sure path can be seen. When we have the presence of the Holy Spirit within, we have all that we need to accomplish what God intends for each day of our lives.
