From Pastor Tim’s Desk

The scripture for today:

Why is it that we so often rely on our own strength, abilities and wisdom to deal with the problems we face? God has told us, "Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit says the Lord of hosts." Zec. 4:6 We often strike out in our own strength, like Peter at Jesus' arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane. Too often we rely on what Paul calls "the wisdom of this world" instead of "the wisdom of God" (1 Cor. 1:20-21), when confronted with challenges! True strength comes from knowing where our weaknesses lie! Maybe one of the few (very few) advantages of aging is that it teaches us the necessity of not relying on our own strength, physical, mental or spiritual, to bulldoze our way through the obstacles and opportunities of life! I'm reminded daily of my need for God's help in dealing with whatever I face. I begin my days with prayer for strength, and, when I'm smart, I repeat them often during the day! I still try my best to maintain and grow what strengths I do have, but never forget "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." (Philippians 4:13) It is my hope that you will take these Scripture passages to heart! My prayer for you is one Paul prayed: "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father...that He would grant you to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love may know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask of think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever.
