From Pastor Tim’s Desk

The scripture for today: Matthew 5:48

Be ye therefore perfect, even as your father who is in heaven is perfect.

God commands nothing of us that He is not willing to do through us. We are commanded to be "perfect" or "complete." That is obviously not something that we can accomplish ourselves. Perfection in the eyes of God is the consistent reflection of His love. The love of God is not something that we manufacture; it comes from Him alone. Regardless of the circumstances or trials of life, God desires to be perfectly reflected in us. "God is love." 1 John 4:8 and only when a life is surrendered to Christ can the love of God be fully expressed through it. That is the state of perfection that God holds for each one of us. We are directed to fully surrender our lives to Him so that, through His indwelling presence, our Father's love is what we share with the world. When God resides in our hearts through the Holy Spirit, He brings with Him His perfect character (*John 14:23*). "For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people." Hebrews 8:10 "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them." (*Hebrews 10:16*) The New Covenant is the same Covenant of Love that has identified who God is throughout the ages. It has been ratified by the sacrifice of Christ. It is the very expression of the character of God and is written upon the heart of every true believer. That heart, which has been surrendered to God, becomes the very property of the Lord. And, out of what belongs to Him, God expresses Himself in His perfect love. We are to be perfect or "complete" because now, through the indwelling presence of Christ, we can be.
