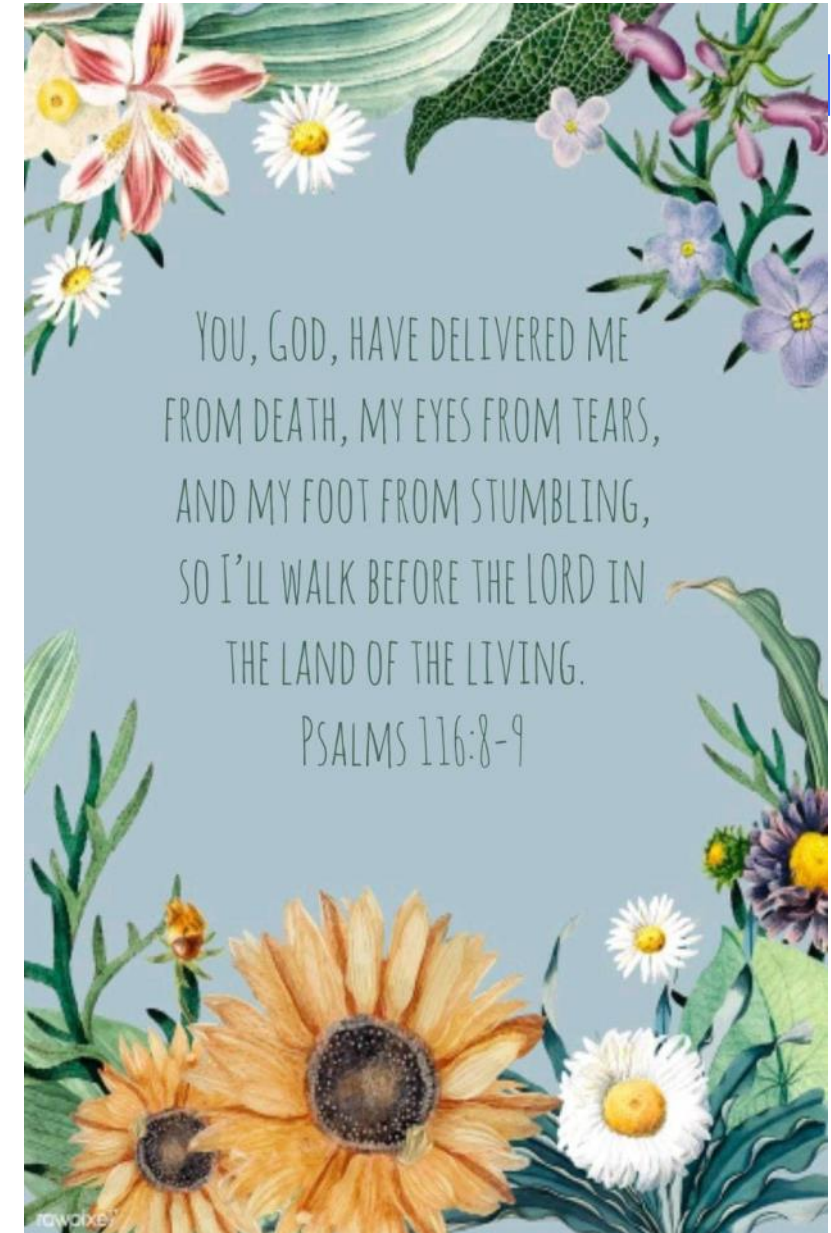

The scripture for today: Psalms 128:1-2

Blessed is everyone that fears the Lord; that walks in His ways. For you shall eat the labor of your hands; happy shall you be, and it shall be well with you.

God promises those who live in reverential fear of Him, who honor Him with their lives, blessings that can only be provided by the Creator. Often people think that wealth is the source of happiness. It has been documented time and again that those who are the most wealthy are not those who are the most happy. True happiness comes from God alone.
