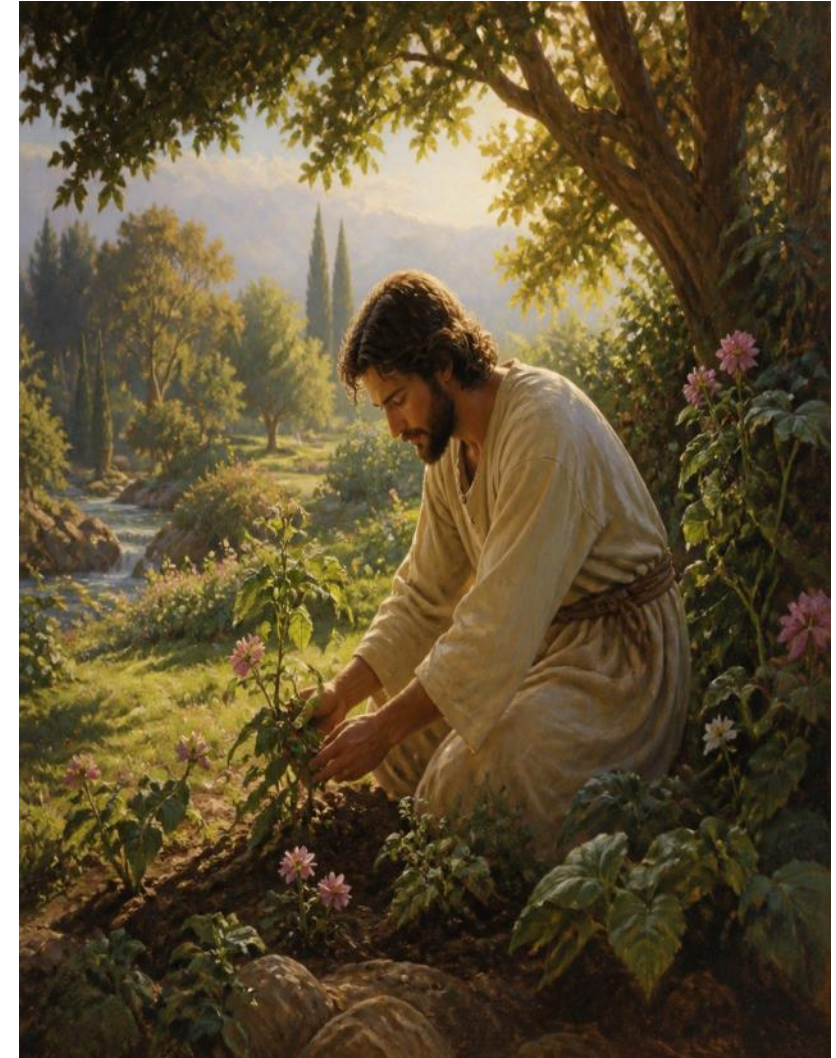

From Pastor Tim’s Desk
The scripture for today: Luke 8:11

Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.

In the parable of the sower, Jesus informed His disciples that the seed planted represented the Word of God. The apostle Peter who was present when Christ gave this revelation later wrote: "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which lives and abides forever." *1 Peter 1:23* Peter gives us some characteristics of the Word. We can readily see that it is the activating power of new life. It has within itself the creation of a born again experience. It is incorruptible and it lives and abides forever. From that seed, new life is received and that life grows and produces fruit from what is contained in the seed. There is power in the Word of God. It changes lives, not just temporarily, but eternally. Good soil is necessary for seed to grow. Our hearts are the soil in which the seed is planted. Every heart has the opportunity to receive the Word of God. Hard and unreceptive hearts reject the Word outright. Shallow hearts give lip service to the Word but never surrender to the truth. Consequently they never grow into fruit bearing offspring, but die off quickly. Distracted hearts are double-minded. They, to some degree, accept the truth of the Word but they also are attracted to the world and other traditions. Eventually they are choked by their duplicity and the seed of truth die out in their lives. The only way to ensure that we are good ground is to surrender to the Word of God as it is imparted to us. Partial obedience is disobedience and delayed obedience leads to continued delay which also is disobedience. If God gives us His Word, and it is planted in our hearts, the only intelligent response is to surrender to it. Surrender to the Word of God is the place of victory for every heart which hears. Our choices reveal the condition of our hearts. Christ Jesus bids the world "Come unto me, all you that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." *Matthew 11:28* May that Word find good soil in every heart.
