The scripture for today: Psalms 119:90

Your faithfulness is unto all generations: you have established the earth and it abides.

The stability of the earth as it orbits the sun is analogous to the unchangeableness of God's word. The heavens and the earth are held in place by the power of God's creative word. "For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast." ***Psalms 33:9*** The appreciation of His creative power helps us to trust His promises.
