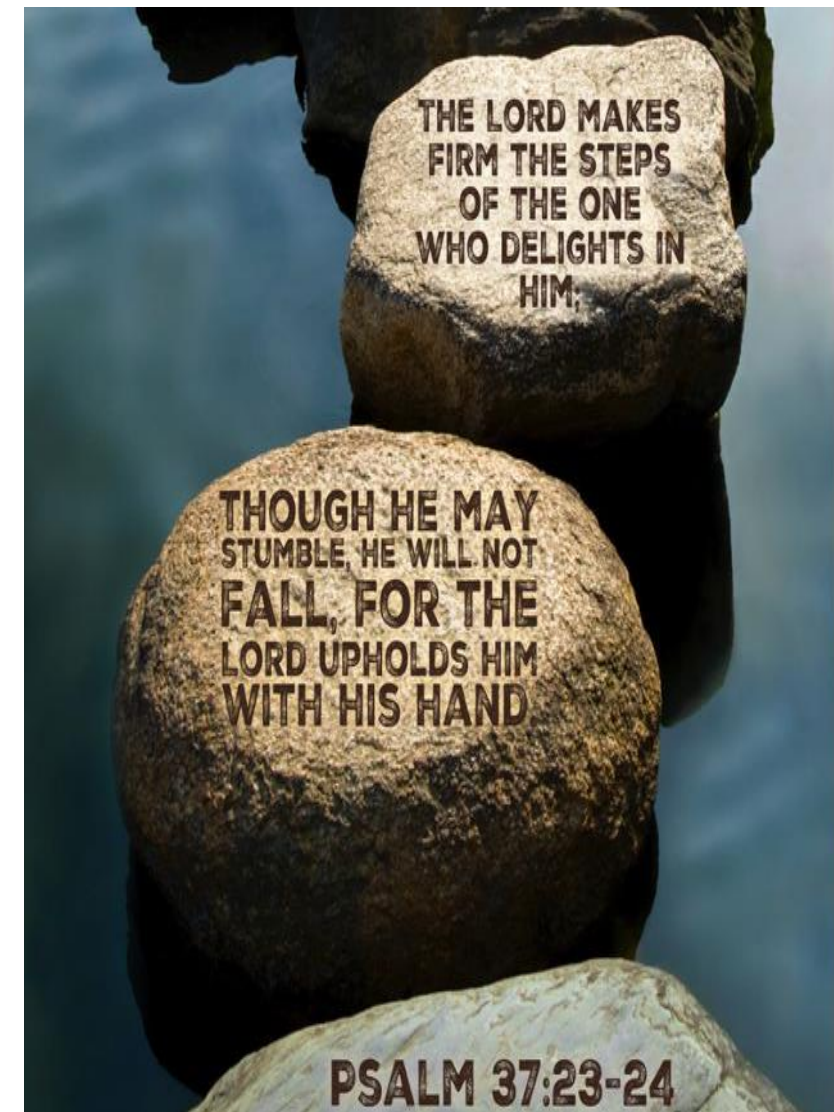

From Pastor Tim's Desk

The scripture for today: 1 Chronicles 17:20

O Lord, there is none like You, nor is there any God besides You, according to all that we have heard with out ears.

In our scripture today, David is touched and humbled by the favor that God has shown him. He has placed him in a place of honor and through His love and mercy has elevated the house of David in the eyes of the nation. David prays in faith. He realizes that there is no God besides the God who created all things. He has heard the testimony of the witnesses of old and has also seen the miracles of God performed in his own life. The recipient of such love and deliverance must acknowledge that no other God exists besides He who is all powerful.

The promises of God for us are as powerful as they were for David. In Christ the promises of God to all of His children are fulfilled. Through Christ He calls us to be kings and priests in His kingdom. Because of the righteousness of Christ which is given to us, He raises us up to rule and reign with Him. If we are then to be with Him in that place of glory and honor, we must live with Him in love, humility and heart surrender now. Christ desires to live in our hearts so that we might be reflections of His life of love and obedience to a world that desperately needs a Savior. There is no God except our God. He alone is the creator and He alone is worthy to be exalted in our lives. May we reflect Him and His light to a world drowning in a sea of darkness. May we forsake all others and follow Him. May we find strength in His promises and may we, as David did, reflect the presence of God in our lives.
