SERVING OUR COMMUNITY THROUGH THE SPECIAL ELECTION 2025

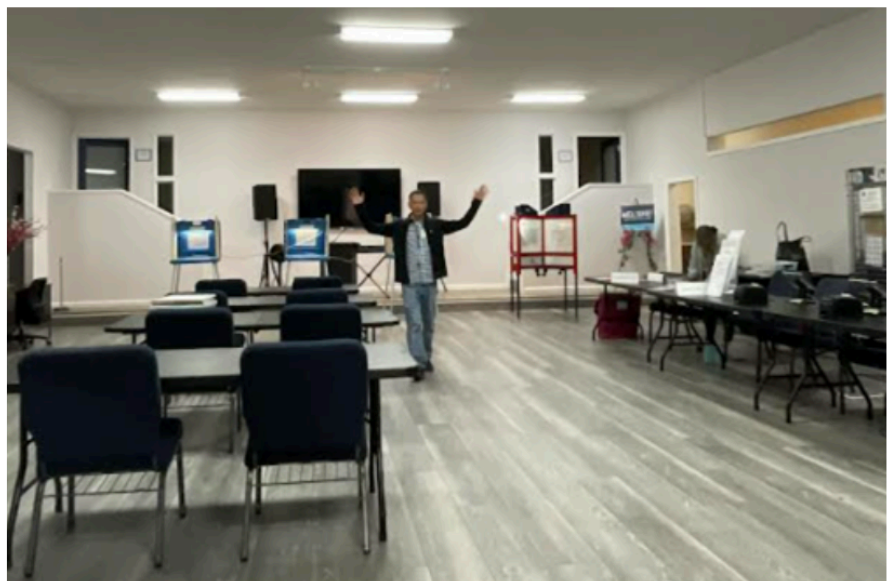
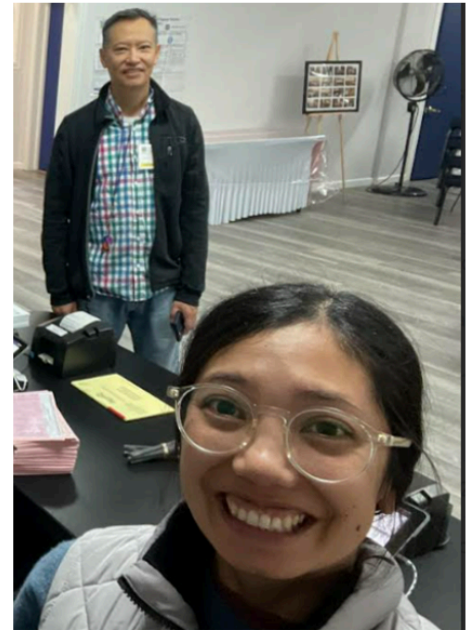
A group from our church family had the privilege of serving as poll workers during the 2025 Statewide Special Election. Together, we helped ensure a smooth and fair voting process for our community.

 **Teamwork & Service:** This experience not only allowed us to contribute to democracy, but also strengthened our bonds as a church community.

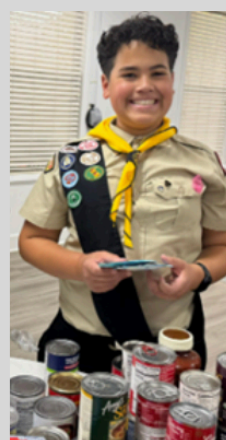
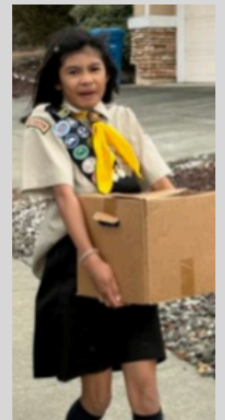
