Meet our GUEST SPEAKER - Pastor Normand Cote:

- **Pastor Cote is born and raised in Prince George, BC,** and served in pastoral ministry in Manitoba-Saskatchewan for 2 years, & British Columbia for 25 years, including previously serving as pastor of Cornerstone Seventh-day Adventist Church, Comox, Campbell River, & Vanderhoof & Lakes district in Burns lake, before becoming pastor at Westminster SDA Church in Vancouver.
- **Doctor of Ministry:** Pastor Cote earned a Doctor of Ministry (D.Min.) degree from Andrews University. His doctoral project focused on how biblical preaching can foster spiritual renewal, unity, and conflict resolution within a local congregation.
- **Emphasis on revival:** His preaching often emphasizes revival, the work of the Holy Spirit, spiritual growth, church unity, and practical Christian living. This focus is reflected in both his doctoral research and his pastoral ministry.

- **Media ministry:** Many of his sermons and communion services have been livestreamed through Westminster SDA's online ministry, allowing members and visitors to watch remotely. Today, Pastor Cote’s church has more than 20,000+ subscribers, which is the leading YouTube Christian broadcast Channel among all Adventist Churches in Canada.
- **Pastor Normand has been happily married to Eva** since 1994. They first met during an evangelistic series, where God brought their lives together. Originally from the Philippines, Eva serves as an Educational Assistant (EA), supporting children with special needs. She is also actively involved in ministry and outreach, faithfully serving alongside Pastor Normand at evangelistic meetings, church programs, and community events. Together, God has blessed them with three children and, more recently, the joy of their first granddaughter.
