

QUICK INFO for SY 2026-2027

APPLICATION/COMPREHENSIVE FEE:

All students, non-refundable **\$200**
(More than one child attending it will be **\$200** for first than **\$100** for the others)
Application fee is \$400 after AUGUST 11th, 2026

TUITION:

Kindergarten through Grade 8 **\$684/Mo or \$6,840/Yr**
3% discount (COST: \$6,634.80) will be applied if Paid In Full by AUGUST 11th, 2026

DEWAR INSURANCE:

Recovery insurance is 2.6% of tuition **\$177.84**

TECHNOLOGY FEE **\$400**

DEWARS & TECHNOLOGY FEE Due by APRIL 1st, 2027

GRADUATION FEE:

Kinder & 8th Grade ONLY **\$100**
Due by April 5th, 2027 – AFTER \$200 (\$100 back from the \$200 if both cap & gown is returned)

YEARBOOK **\$60**

Due by APRIL 5th, 2027 – AFTER \$70

5th – 8th Grade Outdoor School @ Camp Erdman **\$250**

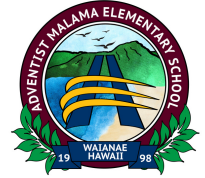
Due by FEBRUARY 2nd, 2027 – AFTER \$250

BILLING, PAYMENTS AND FEES:

- * **Billing: 10 months Plan – August thru May**
Paid in Full Plan – Must be paid before the first day of school
- * **Payment Method: ACH withdrawal from checking or saving bank account**
- * **Bank Withdrawal Dates: Choice between 15th or 25th of each month**
- * **Bank Fee: \$35.00 for Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF)**

UNIFORMS:

Boys and girls of Adventist Malama Elementary will be attired in the selected uniforms. Uniforms are purchased from **TBA**. All students are required to wear a uniform which are to be kept neat and clean at all times. No substitutes or exceptions will be made without consulting the principal. Uniform jackets are required, no exceptions.

MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS

Physical examinations are required for all children entering school for the first time in Hawaii. All new students will be required to provide the school with a completed DOE Form 14 Health Record by a family physician which documents:

- a. Tuberculin test (Mantoux type) with negative results or follow-up x-ray. (TB test must be given not more than 12 months before school entrance.)
- b. Complete or current immunizations
- c. Physical examination

Returning students in grade 7 must provide documentation showing evidence of physical examination, including scoliosis check for 7th grade students

SCHOOL HOURS, PICK-UP, & LUNCH (school calendar can be found on our website)

Monday through Thursday: 7:30 AM – 2:30 PM; Friday's 7:30 -11:30 AM

Students should not arrive on campus before 7:00 AM (unless enrolled with Early Bird Care). The gates will be locked. Please follow the driving on and parking rules on campus given at registration and stated in Handbook.

Students are to bring their own lunches with eating utensils. Provide healthy food.

ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

Students are required by law to attend school regularly. **A valid excuse for absence is sickness or a death in the family. Notes are required to give make-up assignments for missing work.** Parents are asked to cooperate with the school by keeping their child prompt and in good attendance. As much as possible, dental or medical appointments should be made outside of school hours.

TRANSFERS

When a student transfers to this school from another school, a release form from the previous school is required. As a courtesy to the previous school, we will not allow any student to register until arrangements for payment have met the satisfaction of the previous school. When leaving AMES to another school the office needs to be informed. Tuition charges continue until the school is informed.
