Our local chapter meets regularly at the Blue Mountain Grief and Loss Foundation's grief center, where families gather in a safe, compassionate space to be understood and supported by others who truly "get it." These meetings are peer-led, non-religious, and open to anyone in the community who has experienced this kind of loss, regardless of faith background.

BLUE MOUNTAIN GRIEF AND LOSS FOUNDATION

The Blue Mountain Grief and Loss Foundation is a local nonprofit created to make grief support and other end-of-life-related resources accessible and welcoming to our region. The grief center at [1637 E. Isaacs Ave, Suite D](#), opened in January 2025. In addition to hosting The Compassionate Friends, the center is home to a variety of other support offerings, including both professionally facilitated and peer-led grief groups. Some groups are closed, while others are drop-in. Current and recent offerings include:

- **Journey Forward** – A closed, 12-session adult support group for a variety of death-related losses
- **After the Unthinkable** – A drop-in grief support group for those grieving a loss by suicide
- **Journey Forward (Senior Spouse/Partner)** – A closed, 12-session support group for those age 68 and older who have lost a spouse or partner
- **Dementia Caregiver Support Group** – A 10-session group for those supporting a person living with dementia
