This application will need to be submitted again for the 2nd semester, but without the need of your tax document.

The 3-way plan is shared by the local church, the school and the Southern New England SDA Conference. This application will set the following process into motion:

Step 1. This application and your 1040 Tax form must be submitted to the WHCS Treasurer to determine eligibility and the amount of the scholarship to be awarded.

Step 2. Upon approval, the school treasurer will email your local church pastor with the eligible amount.

Step 3. Once the local church votes to appropriate the matching funds for this program, the local church treasurer needs to send the check for the church's portion to the school treasurer at Wachusett Hills Christian School, 100 Colony Rd., Westminster, MA 0143.

Step 4. Following the receipt of the local church portion, the school will post the total amount of the award to the parent's tuition statement as a pro-rated monthly entry.
