## Parent/Guardian Expectations.

**The adventurer club is run sole by volunteers. We love creating opportunities for our children to grow physically, socially, emotionally and spiritually. For this to be successful we request your help in attempting the following.**

**We expect the child's parents (or responsible adult) to be:**

**Present:** Adventurers is geared toward kids younger then 10 years old. This is developmentally a wonderful time of with the family. Family is the center of their life. We strive to make our activities fun for the whole family, and when you are present you can see your child grow and develop.

**Engaged:** When your child sees you be a part of the fun, it helps them get into it even more. Don't be shy, jump in! Help with craft, sing the songs, check in with your child. We want to help strengthen your connection with your child.

**Committed:** Children do well with structure, and if they know that they are part of the club, they want to be involved in everything that the club is doing. Of course, life happens and we can't control everything, but to the best of your ability help your child learn what it means to be responsible, by helping them be able to come.

## Adventurer Uniform

We have three types of uniforms. The uniform that is required at each activity is noted in the calendar/schedule.



### Class A- Full Dress Uniform

The club will loan you a class A uniform during the year. You will need to return this uniform every year, except the sash and scarf.

#### Girls

Navy blue pleated jumper  
Light blue or white blouse with straight collar and short/long sleeves  
Navy blue socks or tights

#### Boys

Navy blue pants  
· Light blue or white shirt with straight collar and short/long sleeves  
· Black or Navy blue socks

#### Boys and Girls

- Black shoes (uniform within club)
- Scarf and Slide Burgundy Adventurer scarf worn with an Adventurer slide.
- Sash The sash is navy blue. It is worn from the right shoulder to the left hip. Adventurer stars, chips, awards, pins, event patches, pins and other club related items may be displayed on the sash.
- Navy blue beret

Please make sure your uniform is clean and unwrinkled. Uniforms must be free from non-Adventurer or unearned pins and patches.

### **Class B: Field uniform**

- Club T-shirt- if colder weather can put over long sleeve under shirt.
- Jeans or pants.
- Comfortable shoes/socks
- o All parts should be free from holes or tears.

### **Class C: Comfortable**

From time to time we will be participating in service, sports or outdoor activities in which you can wear regular clothes. Please make sure that these clothes follow these guidelines:

- Modest/Practical- Allows the child to move and play without interruption
- Does not have logos or pictures that are scary, war like, etc.
- Is appropriate to the weather.
- Avoid jewelry to prevent accidents or loss of items.
