In the support of the gospel through tithes and offerings. Leviticus 27:30-32; Malachi 3:8-11; Matthew 23:23

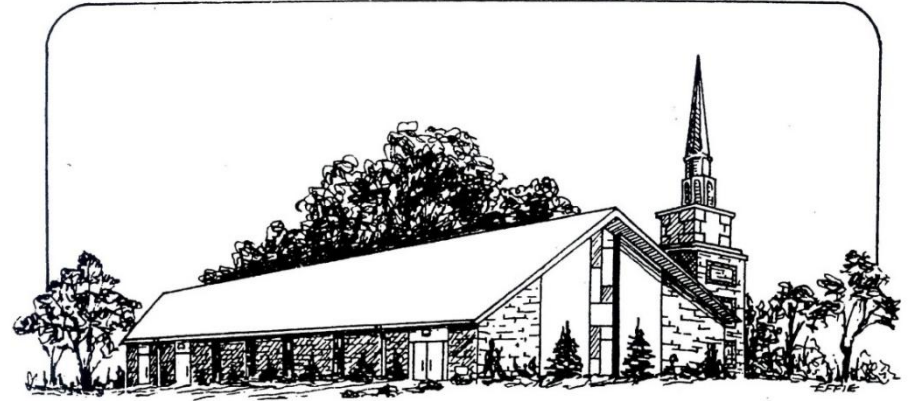
In baptism by immersion. Mark 1:9-10; Romans 6:3-5; Matthew 28:19-20
