Adventist Learning Center provides quality, faith-based education to Syrian and Kurdish Refugees living in Beirut, Lebanon. Teachers from around the world come together to create a safe, stable, and loving environment where refugee kids can learn academics, character growth, and more about God.



Lunch Program

Each student, volunteer and staff at Adventist Learning Center are provided with a healthy lunch during the course of the school year. Many of the students face poor nutrition at home and they are able to have a healthy balanced meal at least once per day.

All meals are vegetarian and include an entree (such as rice, pasta, beans, lentils, potatoes or hummus), something fresh (such as salad, fruits, or chopped veggies), and bread. Occasionally, eggs and yogurt are served.

Sponsors can send letters to the student they have chose to sponsor and will always receive letters a few times each year.

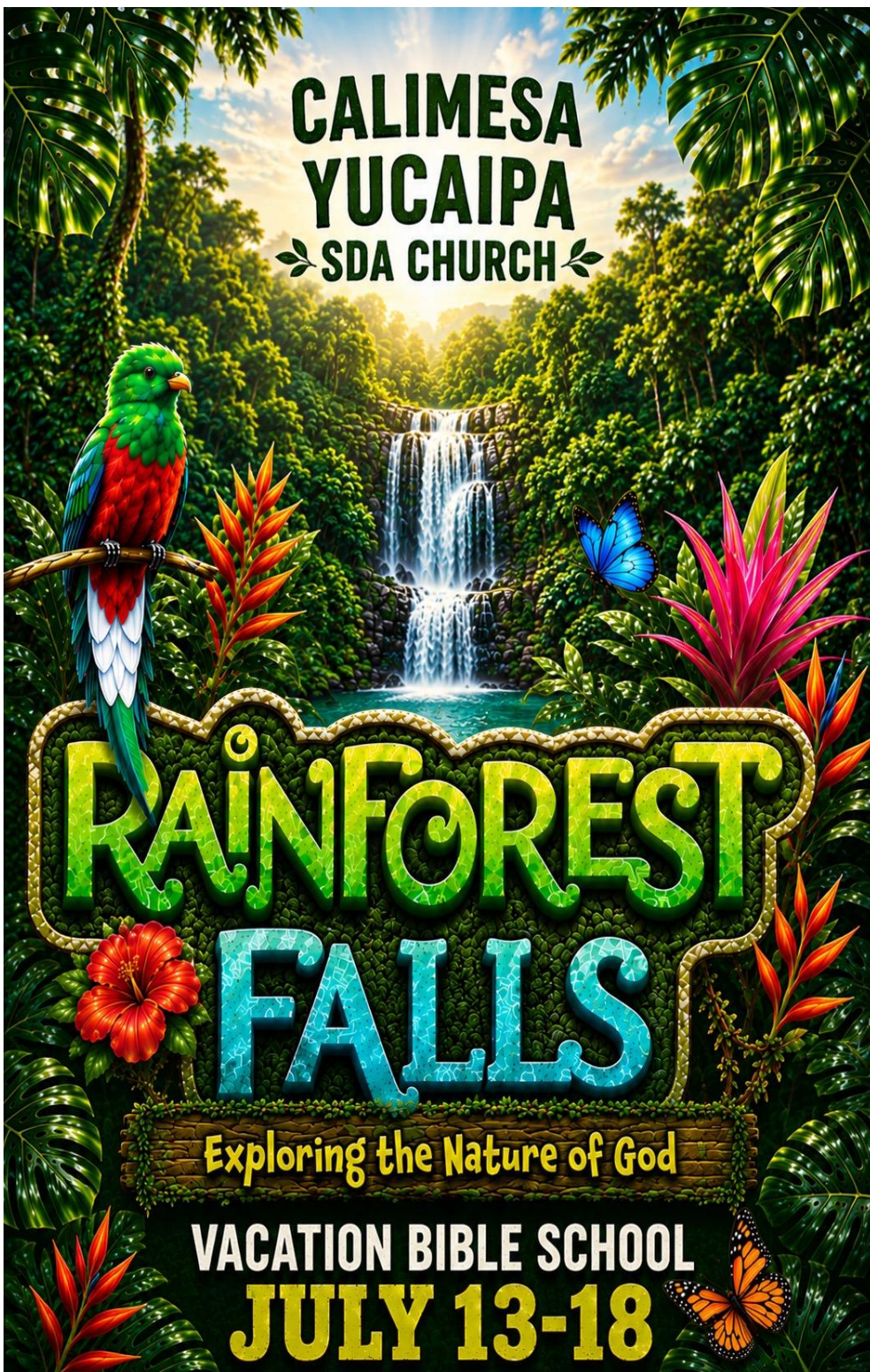
