9. **BLESSED BY: A Miracle**

Over the past few months my nephew Elijah has been going thru a difficult medical journey. At the same time his sister has been going through her own long battle with pancreatic cancer. So when Elijah suspected his symptoms were of the same nature he went to the doctor.

On the 1st visit the doctor assured him it was nothing. Then a few months later and more tests, they said indeed it was pancreatic cancer and it had metastasized to his lungs and now required aggressive cancer treatment.

As always we went to the Lord in prayer for His help and guidance. Elijah and I spoke of how we felt peace and trust that it was in God's hands.

I want to share this miracle of answered prayer with you because our church prayer team has been praying for Elijah, so this miracle is also yours.

Elijah told the doctor, "Before we start the treatment, I would like to have testing to see how far it had gone." The doctors came back and said, "The cancer was gone except for a small spot, and we can remove that surgically."

I am asking the church family to pray for Elijah. The surgery will be done next Thursday, Aug. 20. Pray for the complete healing of Elijah, and that this miracle will draw Elijah closer to the Lord, and that it will strengthen YOUR faith and trust in God as you go through your own trials.
