



Zanesville Adventist School Supply List



Each Grade 1-8 student will need the following:

General Supplies (please put the student's name on these items)

- 1 lunch box and backpack
- 1 pencil box for general supplies
- 1 refillable/reusable water bottle (spill-proof)
- 6 no. 2 pencils (**sharpened** before the first day of school)
- 2 pink erasers
- 1 bottle of Elmer's liquid glue
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 ruler (inches and centimeters)
- 2 packets of notebook paper (wide-ruled)
- 1 2-pocket folder

Art Supplies (We have found it very useful to put a name on each individual crayon etc. with a permanent marker pen. It helps get the item back to its rightful owner.)

- 1 pencil box or soft pencil bag to keep some art supplies in
- 1 art apron (this could be an old shirt that a parent or grandparent no longer uses)
- 2 fine point black permanent marker pens
- 1 box of 24 or 48 Crayola crayons
- 1 package of Crayola colored pencils
- 1 package of colored markers (washable, basic colors)

Supplies to be shared (Do not name these items)

- 2 packets of 500 sheet white photocopy paper
 - 3 containers of anti bacterial wipes
 - 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
 - 3 boxes of tissues
 - Grade 1-2 = 1 package of Expo White board markers and 1 package of plastic spoons
 - Grade 3-4 = 1 package of Expo White board markers and 1 package of plastic spoons
 - Grade 5-6 = 1 box of ziploc quart bags and 1 package of plastic forks
 - Grade 7-8 = 1 box of ziploc gallon bags 1 package of plastic forks

Grade 5-8 (only) will also need the following items:

- 1 composition book (wide-ruled lines)
- 1 calculator (grade 7 and 8 will need a scientific calculator)
- 1 Math compass and protractor
- 2 highlighter pens (any color)
- 2 3-ring binders (1 inch)
- 1 package of 50 sheet protectors (clear)

Grades K-2 will also need spare clothes (to be kept at school in case of bathroom accidents)

- 1 pair of underwear, 1 t-shirt, 1 pair of shorts/pants/skirt, and 1 pair of socks (placed in a named bag).

Note: It is important that the children keep the necessary school supplies **at school**. It is highly recommended that similar supplies are available at home for students to do their homework.
